DATE 1 August

GOD'S CREATION AND PEOPLE ARE BROKEN BY SIN

Activity & Intro

Creation walk: take children for a walk around the school grounds and talk about things you can see that God made that are broken, decayed or dead. [NB: Last week children did same activity but observed things God made]. Children could collect these items they see along the way. Show and discuss items before returning to library.

Before going to discussion groups have children tidy chairs back under tables

Discussion Groups

1. Do you think the snake forced Adam and Eve to eat the fruit or do you think they had a choice?
2. Do we have choices today to live God's way or our own way? [ask for examples of when they have to make choices in their lives]
3. How can we have help to live God's way? [We can remember that God is our Creator who loves us and made us for a purpose. God has promised to love us and forgive us. We can ask God to help us live his way]
4. Who did God send to deal with the problem of sin? [Jesus] [use these answers as ideas for prayer together]

Activity (over page)

Each group needs a set of dominoes

Activity

Dominoes

Remind the children that Adam & Eve's sin affected all the people who followed them.

Children set up dominoes on their edges so that if one domino is toppled the rest will fall. When the dominoes are set up. Allow them to knock the first domino over and set off a chain reaction.

Playground
